

COLLEGE-PREP JUNIOR GOLF CAMP

*The Chechessee Creek Club
Okatie, South Carolina
June 24 to June 30, 2012*



The Concept: The camp is for boys and is designed to prepare junior high and high school golfers for participation in varsity college golf programs. The program will include:-

- Instruction in all departments of golf, long and short game with a strong emphasis on correct practice habits and video feedback,
- Golf fitness and dietary considerations to maximize performance, based on TPI (Titleist Performance Institute ideals)
- Course management in a competitive environment. Handling competitive stress and understanding and dealing with negative on-course behavior.
- Planning and preparing for tournaments; dealing with geographical and weather related course conditions.
- Learning about college golf; researching the best programs based on personal academic goals, college academic requirements and level of expertise required to participate at the various levels of college golf.
- Golf rules and golf course etiquette, course conduct and basic golf course agronomy

The Site: The Chechessee Creek Club is ranked 29th in Golf World's top-fifty private clubs in the nation, Chechessee Creek Club offers a classical 'Low Country' golf experience. Measuring barely 6600 yards, the Bill Coore - Ben Crenshaw gem lends itself to old-country golf. Chechessee is a walkers course, designed in the old tradition with the next tee no more than a soft wedge away. It appears benign, some would call it a cake-walk, that is, until you reach its small, contoured, elevated Ross-like greens. Students may have the opportunity to play other courses in the area, depending on availability. Chechessee Creek has a full service driving range, bunker, chipping and putting green.

Mon. June 25	Introduction to TPI (Titleist Performance Institute) training, morning short game and range practice. Afternoon on course golf management, focus on planning your round. Evening video sessions with PGA film library study of winning athletes
Tues. June 26	TPI training, morning short game and range practice. Afternoon on course management, control and temperament. Evening video with PGA film library, review of college programs, academics, where you fit. Admission needs. NCAA regulations and USGA rules
Wed. June 27	TPI training, building power, morning short game and range practice. Afternoon on course, focus on club values, distance, club selection. Evening video sessions, performance, NCAA regulations and USGA rules. Junior golf tours, building a resume of your golf performance.
Thus. June 28	Physical training, morning short game and range practice. Afternoon on course management on the course. Evening video sessions with Evening planning session for tomorrow's competitive round. Setting realistic goals and meeting them
Fri. June 29	Morning warm up on range. Lunch at the club. Afternoon student team and individual college format golf event. Awards dinner. Parents invited to join the event and awards dinner

The Site: Chechessee Creek Club is ranked 29th. in Golf World's top-fifty private clubs in the nation, Chechessee Creek Club offers a classical 'Low Country' golf experience. Chechessee is a walkers course, designed in the old tradition with the next tee no more than a soft wedge away. A member of the school staff will meet students at the Savannah Airport and deliver them to the Chechessee Creek Club.

Lodging: Students will stay in cottages on the Chechessee Creek Golf Club property. Six students to each cottage under the supervision of an adult school staff member. Each twin bedroom will have a private bath.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served at the Chechessee Creek Club.

Golf Courses: The Chechessee Creek Club is our base of operation for afternoon on course instruction. To help expand your playing experience and depending on availability you may be able to play some afternoon golf on neighborhood courses, depending on availability.

Conduct: We expect all student participants to observe proper golf etiquette on all facilities at all times. Outside school hours students are also expected to be well-mannered and polite towards club staff and club members of clubs affiliated with the program. Abuse of property both on and off golf school facilities is not tolerated and could lead to suspension from the program.

Insurance: Although all our golf programs are fully insured, we recommend parents or guardians take additional travel insurance in case of medical and emergencies.

Medical and emergency Facilities: Beaufort Hospital is located 20 minutes from Chechessee Creek Club and offers 24-hour emergency services. The Chechessee/Spring Island Fire department and emergency service is adjacent to the Chechessee Creek Club gate.
